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CHAPTER – 1

INTRODUCTION

The Parliament of India enacted the Right to Information Act, 2005 which received the assent of the President of India on 15.06.2005. While some provisions of the Act came into force at once, some others came into effect on the one hundred and fiftieth day of its enactment. The Act extends to the whole of India except the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

The basic objective of the Right to Information Act is to empower the citizens, promote transparency and accountability in the working of the Government, contain corruption and make Indian democracy work for the people in real sense. The Act is a big step towards the citizens informed about the activities of the Government.

The Right to Information Act has a comprehensive reach and covers a wide spectrum of bodies. All the Departments and undertakings of the Central and State Governments, institutions, agencies and other bodies established, constituted, owned, controlled or substantially financed by Governments including non-governmental organizations come under the Act. Every citizen of India has the right to information accessible under the Act which is held by or under the control of any public authority. Such accessible information includes inspection of documents or records, taking certified samples of material, cassettes or in any other electronic mode or through printouts where such information is stored in a computer or in any other device.

As provided under section 15 (1) of The Right to Information Act, 2005, the Mizoram Information Commission was constituted vide notification No. F.13011/11/2005 – IPR dated 29.6.2006. The Commission started functioning from 5th July 2006 when Mr. Robert Hrangdawla, IAS (Rtd.) and Mr. K. Tlanthanga, IB (P) S (Rtd.) were administered oath of office as Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioner respectively. Mr. Robert Hrangdawla, however, demitted office on 1.2.2010 on attaining the age of 65 years as per section 16 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 and no Chief Information Commissioner has been appointed during the period under report. However, the new chief Information Commissioner, Mr. Lal Dingliana, Indian Foreign Service (rtd.) was appointed on 8th August 2011.

Section 25 of the Right to Information Act provides that the Central Information Commission or the State Information Commission shall prepare a report on the implementation of the provisions of the Act after the end of each year and forward the report to the appropriate Government for laying it before the Parliament or the State Legislature. This report has been prepared in compliance with sub – section (1) of the Right to Information Act.

As provided under section 27 (1) of the Act, the Government of Mizoram made the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006 which was notified under No. F.13011/4/2005 – IPR dated 21.06.2006. However, owing to certain defects in the Rules, complete proposal for amendment to the Rules was submitted to the State Government in terms of rule 19 of the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006. The State Government, in effect, has notified ‘The Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2010’ vide No. F.13011/4/2008 – IPR dated 20.9.2010 which was gazetted on 24.11.2010.

The Mizoram Information Commission is pleased to present its fifth Annual Report covering the period from April 2010 to March 2011.

CHAPTER – 2

SALIENT FEATURES OF RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

The right to information is a powerful tool in the hands of the common people and the Right to Information Act, 2005, has empowered every citizen of the country to seek information from various public authorities. The Act prescribes disclosure of information suo moto on the working of the public authorities which has to be updated every year and designation of Public Information Officers and Assistant Public Information Officers who will receive and process the requests for information from any information seeker and give the required information within the specified time limit. The Act also prescribes designations of Appellate Authority by every public authority to consider the appeal against the decision of the Public Information Officer. Information Commissions have been constituted by the Central Government and the State Governments to inquire into complaints or appeals and to monitor implementation of the provisions of the Act by the public authorities.

The salient points of the Right to Information Act, 2005, may be summarized as follows:-

- (i) Every citizen of India can seek information from any public authority without specifying the reason for seeking the information.
- (ii) Public authorities are to furnish the required information to the applicants through the designated Public Information Officers within the specified time.
- (iii) The required information can be denied only under exemptions provided in the RTI Act, 2005.

- (iv) Person desirous of obtaining information under the Act has to make a request in writing to the Central Public Information Officer or State Public Information Officer.
- (v) The information to the applicant should ordinarily be provided in the form in which it is sought.
- (vi) The application should be made either in English, Hindi or in the official language of the area in which the application is made.
- (vii) Fees for information as may be prescribed are chargeable. Persons belonging to BPL are not liable to pay any fee provided BPL cards are produced.
- (viii) When a request for information has been rejected, the State Public Information Officer shall communicate to the person making the request –
 - the reasons for such rejection;
 - the period within which an appeal against such rejection may be preferred; and
 - the particulars of the Appellate Authority.
- (ix) The Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer shall provide the required information or reject the request within 30 days of receipt of such request.
- (x) Person aggrieved by the decision of the PIO has the right to prefer an appeal within 30 days before the First or Departmental Appellate Authority (DAA) designated by the concerned authority.

- (xi) Person aggrieved by the decision of the First or Departmental Appellate Authority (DAA) has the right to prefer a second appeal within 90 days before the Central or State information Commission. The decision of the Central or State Information Commission is final and binding on the public authority.
- (xii) Information concerning the life and liberty of a person has to be given within 48 hours from receipt of the application.
- (xiii) Every public authority is required to make voluntary disclosure of information of its functioning which is to be updated every year.
- (xiv) The public authorities are required to designate adequate number of Public Information Officers and Assistant Public Information Officers to provide information to the applicants.
- (xv) The public authorities are required to designate the Appellate Authorities to consider and decide the first appeals against the decisions of the Public Information Officers.
- (xvi) The Central or State information Commission has the power to impose penalty upon, and to recommend disciplinary action against, the Public Information Officer on grounds specified under the Act.
- (xvii) The provisions of the Act have an overriding effect on any other law for the time being in force including the provisions of the Official Secrets Act, 1923.
- (xviii) Courts (Civil and Criminal) have no jurisdiction under this Act.
- (xix) The appropriate Government and competent authorities are empowered to make rules to carry out the provisions of the Act.

- (xx) The appropriate Government is required by sub – section (1) of Section 26 to perform the following:-
- to develop and organize educational programmes to advance the understanding of the public as to how to exercise the rights contemplated under the Act;
 - to encourage public authorities to participate in the development and organization of educational programmes and to undertake such programmes themselves;
 - to promote timely and effective dissemination of accurate information by public authorities about their activities; and
 - to train State Public Information Officers of the public authorities and produce relevant training materials for use by the public authorities themselves.

CHAPTER – 3
POWERS OF THE STATE INFORMATION COMMISSION,
APPEAL AND PENALTIES UNDER THE RIGHT
TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005

Powers and functions of the State Information Commission, appeal and penalties under the Right to Information Act, 2005, are reproduced below:

(a) Enquiries under section 18 of the Act:-

(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, it shall be the duty of the State Information Commission to receive and inquire into a complaint from any person -

- who has been unable to submit a request to a State Public Information Officer either by reason that no such officer has been appointed under this Act, or because the State Assistant Public Information Officer has refused to accept his or her application for information or appeal under this Act for forwarding the same to the State Public Information Officer or senior officer specified in sub – section (1) of section 19 or the State Information Commission, as the case may be;
- who has been refused access to any information requested under this Act;
- who has not been given a response to a request for information or access to information within the time limit specified under this Act;
- who has been required to pay an amount of fee which he or she considers unreasonable;

- who believes that he or she has been given incomplete, misleading or false information under this Act; and
 - in respect of any other matter relating to requesting or obtaining access to records under this Act;
- (2) Where the State Information Commission is satisfied that there are reasonable grounds to inquire into the matter, it may initiate an inquiry in respect thereof.
- (3) The State Information Commission shall, while inquiring into any matter under this section, have the same powers as are vested in a civil court while trying a suit under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1980, in respect of the following matters, namely :-
- summoning and enforcing the attendance of persons and compel them to give oral or written evidence on oath and to produce the documents or things;
 - requiring the discovery and inspection of the documents;
 - receiving evidence on affidavit;
 - requisitioning any public record or copies thereof from any court or office;
 - issuing summons for examination of the witnesses or documents; and
 - any other matter which may be prescribed.
- (4) Notwithstanding anything inconsistent contained in any other Act of State Legislature, the State Information Commission may, during the inquiry of any complaint under this Act, examine any record to which this Act applies which is under the control of the public authority, and no such record may be withheld from it on any grounds.

(b) Appeals under section 19 of the Act:-

- (1) Any person who does not receive a decision within the time specified in sub – section (1) or clause (a) of sub – section (3) of section 7 or is aggrieved by a decision of the State Public Information Officer may, within thirty days from the expiry of such period or from the receipt of such a decision, prefer an appeal to such officer who is senior in rank to the State Public Information Officer in each public authority:

Provided that such officer may admit the appeal after the expiry of the period of thirty days if he or she is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from filing the appeal in time.

- (2) Where an appeal is preferred against an order made by a State Public Information Officer under section 11 to disclose third party information, the appeal by the concerned third party shall be made within thirty days from the date of the order.
- (3) A second appeal against the decision under sub – section (1) shall lie within ninety days from the date on which the decision should have been made or was actually received with the State Information Commission.

Provided that the State information Commission may admit the appeal after the expiry of the period of ninety days if it is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from filing the appeal in time.

- (4) If the decision of the State Public Information Officer against which an appeal is preferred relates to information of a third party, the State Information Commission shall give a reasonable opportunity of being heard to that third party.

- (5) In any appeal proceedings, the onus to prove that a denial of a request was justified shall be on the State Public Information Officer who denied the request.
- (6) Appeal under sub – section (1) or sub – section (2) shall be disposed of within thirty days of the receipt of the appeal or within such extended period not exceeding a total of forty-five days from the date of filing thereof, as the case may be, for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- (7) The decision of the State Information Commission shall be binding.
- (8) In its decision, the State Information Commission has the power to -
 - (a) require the public authority to take any such steps as may be necessary to secure compliance with the provisions of this Act, including –
 - by providing access to information, if so requested in a particular form;
 - by appointing a State Public Information Officer, as the case may be;
 - by publishing certain information or categories of information;
 - by making necessary changes to its practices in relation to the maintenance, management and destruction of records;
 - by enhancing the provision of training on the right to information for its officials;
 - by providing it with an annual report in compliance with clause (b) of sub – section (1) of section 4;

- (b) require the public authority to compensate the complainant for any loss or other detriment suffered.
 - (c) impose any of the penalties provided under this Act;
 - (d) reject the application.
- (9) The State Information Commission shall give notice of its decisions, including any right of appeal to the complainant and the public authority.
- (10) State Information Commission shall decide the appeal in accordance with such procedure as may be prescribed.

Penalties under Section 20 of the Act:-

- (1) Where the State Information Commission, at the time of deciding any complaint or appeal, is of the opinion that the State Public Information Officer, without any reasonable cause, refused to receive an application for information or has not furnished information within the time specified under sub – section (1) of section 7 or malafidely denied the request for information or knowingly given incorrect, incomplete or misleading information or destroyed information which was the subject of the request or obstructed in any manner in furnishing the information, it shall impose a penalty of two hundred and fifty rupees each day till application is received or information is furnished. However, the total amount of such penalty shall not exceed twenty –five thousand rupees:

Provided that the State Public Information Officer, shall be given a reasonable opportunity of being heard before any penalty is imposed on him;

Provided further that the burden of providing that he acted reasonably and diligently shall be on the State Public Information Officer.

- (2) Where the State Information Commission, at the time of deciding any complaint or appeal, is of the opinion that the State Public Information Officer has, without any reasonable cause and persistently, failed to receive an information or has not furnished information specified under sub – section (1) of Section 7 or malafidely denied the request for information or knowingly given incorrect, incomplete or misleading information or destroyed information which was the subject of the request or obstructed in any manner in furnishing the information, it shall recommend for disciplinary action against the State Public Information Officer under the service rules applicable to him.

CHAPTER – 4

THE MIZORAM RIGHT TO INFORMATION RULES, 2010.

In order to carry out the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005, the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006 was made by the State Government vide Notification No. F.13011/4/2005 – IPR dated 21.6.2006. However, the Rules were found defective in certain ways and the Information Commission submitted proposal for amendment to the Rules. In effect, the State Government has notified the ‘Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2010’ vide No. F.13011/4/2008 – IPR dated 20.9.2010 which was published in the Mizoram Gazette on 24.11.2010. The Rules are reproduced below:-

NOTIFICATION

No. F.13011/4/2008 –IPR, the 20th September, 2010. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub – section 27 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005), the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:

- (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2010.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions:

In these rules unless the context otherwise requires –

- (a) ‘Act ‘ means the Right to Information Act, 200;
- (b) All other words and expressions used herein but not defined in the Act shall have the same meaning assigned respectively to them in the Act.
- (c) ‘Commission’ means the Mizoram Information Commission;
- (d) ‘Section’ means the section of the Act;
- (e) The expression “substantially financed” in relation to a body or non – government organization as occurred in sub – clause (d), (i) & (ii) of clause (h) of Section 2 of the Act shall mean any body or non – governmental organization which is financed by the State Government by giving or extending support or grant, by whatever name called inclusive of stipend, scholarship, grant, grant – in – aid, assistance, etc..., either by means of budget or cash or in kind the value of which is calculable in monetary terms the amount or value, as the case may be, of which is not less than 30 % of the cost of its project, scheme, programme or by whatever name its activities may be called or rupees one lakh, whichever is less.

3. Request for obtaining information:

- (1) A request for obtaining information under – section (1) of section 6 to the State Public Information Officer shall be accompanied by an application fee of Rupees Ten by way of cash against proper receipt or by treasury challan or demand draft or bankers cheque or Indian Postal Order(IPO) payable to the State Public Information Officer of the office of the public authority.

- (2) On receipt of an application, the State Public Information Officer or the State Assistant Public Information officer shall give a receipt in token thereof to the applicant.

4. Fee for providing information:

- (1) For providing information under sub – section (1) or sub – section (5) of section 7, the fee chargeable by way of cash against proper receipt or by treasury challan or demand draft or bankers cheque or Indian Postal Order (IPO) payable to the State Public Information Officer of the office of the public authority shall be at the following rates:
 - (a) Rupee One for each page (in A - 4 or A – 3 size paper) created or copied;
 - (b) Actual charge or cost price of a copy in larger size paper;
 - (c) Actual charge or cost price for samples or models; and
 - (d) For inspection of records, no fee for the first hour and a fee of Rupees five for each subsequent hour (or fraction thereof).
 - (e) For information provided in soft copy Rupees Thirty per CD.
 - (f) For information provided in printed form at the price fixed for such publications or Rupee One per page of photocopy for extracts from the publication.

5. Deposit of Fees:

Any fee collected under these Rules shall be deposited under Head of Account:

6. Fee not chargeable: No fee shall be charged on the following cases:-

- (a) Persons who are of Below Poverty Line as tmay be determined by the State Government of Mizoram for provisions of information related to welfare of BPL.
- (b) Where the State Public Information Officer fails to comply with the time limit specified under sub – section (1) of Section 7 of the Act or where the application is deemed to have been refused on the information being given, the same shall be given free of cost.
- (c) Where an information is such which should have been published or disseminated widely as required by Section 4 of the Act but has not been published nor disseminated, no fee for such information shall be charged.

7. Procedure of appeal:

(1) Contents of appeal: An appeal to the Departmental Appellate Authority/Commission as the case may b, shall contain the following information, namely;

- (a) name and address of the applicant;

- (b) name and address of the Departmental Appellate Authority/ State Public Information Officer, as the case may be, against the decision of whom the appeal is preferred;
 - (c) particulars of the order including number and date, if any, against which the appeal is preferred;
 - (d) brief facts leading to the appeal;
 - (e) if the appeal is preferred against deemed refusal, the particulars of the application, including number and date and name and address of the Departmental Appellate Authority/ State Public Information Officer, as the case may be, to whom the application was made;
 - (f) prayer or relief sought;
- (2) **Documents to accompany appeal:** Every appeal made to the Departmental Appellate Authority/ Commission shall be accompanied by the following documents, namely:
- (a) self – attested true copy of the orders or documents against which the appeal is being preferred.
 - (b) Copies of documents relied upon by the appellant and referred to in the appeal.
- (3) **Procedure in deciding appeal:** For deciding the appeal the Departmental Authority/ Commission may –
- (a) hear oral or written evidence on oath or an affidavit from concerned or interested person;
 - (b) persue or inspect documents, public records or copies thereof;

- (c) enquire or get an enquiry conducted through authorized officer further details or facts;
 - (d) hear State public Information Officer, State Assistant Public Information Officer or such Senior Officer who decided the first appeal, or such person against whom the complaint is made, as the case may be;
 - (e) hear a third party; and
 - (f) receive evidence on affidavits from State Public Information Officer, State Assistant Information Officer, such senior Officer who decided the first appeal, such person against whom the complaint lies or the third party.
- (4) **Service of notice :** Notice to be issued by the Departmental Appellate Authority/ Commission may be served in any of the following modes, namely:
- (a) service by the party itself;
 - (b) by hand delivery (dasti) through Process Server;
 - (c) by registered post with acknowledgement due; or
 - (d) through Head of Office or Department.
- (5) **Personal presence of the appellant or complainant:**
- (a) The appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, shall in every case be informed of the date of hearing at least seven clear days before that date.
 - (b) The appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, may at his discretion at the time of hearing of the appeal or complain by the Departmental Appellate Authority/ State Information Commission be present in person or through his duly authorized representative or may opt not to be present.

- (c) Where the Departmental Authority/ State Information Commission is satisfied that the circumstances exist due to which the appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, was prevented from attending the hearing of the Departmental Appellate Authority/ State Information Commission, then, the Commission may accord the appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, further opportunity of being heard before a final decision is taken or take any other appropriate action as it may deem fit.
- (d) The appellant or the complainant, as the case may be, may seek assistance of any person in the process of the appeal while presenting his points.

(6) Order of the Appellate Authority: Order of the Appellate Authority shall be pronounced in open court and be in writing duly authenticated by the Appellate Authority for this purpose.

8. Power to amend Rules:

The State Government, in consultation with or on recommendation of the Commission may add to, delete from or alter or amend the Rules. Such alteration or amendment of the Rules shall be laid before the State legislature.

9. **Repeal and Saving:** The Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006 are hereby repealed.

Provided that Rule 8 of the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006, shall be deemed to have repealed with effect from 21.6.2006;

Provided that any order made or action taken under the Rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.

CHAPTER – 5

THE MIZORAM INFORMATION COMMISSION

The Mizoram Information Commission was constituted by the by the Sate Government vide notification No. F. 13011/11/2005 – IPR dated 29.6.2006 and Mr. Robert Hrangdawla, IAS (Rtd) and Mr. K. Tlanthanga, IB(P)S (Rtd) were sworn in as the first Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioner respectively on 5.7.2006. Since, however, Mr. Robert Hrangdawla relinquished the office on 1.2.2010 as per Section 16 (1) of the Right to Information Act, no Chief Information Commissioner has been appointed and the Commission functioned with the Information Commissioner during the period under report. Having had no building of its own, the office of the commission is temporarily arranged in an All India Service Officer's Residential Building in the New Secretariat Complex till date.

For effective implementation of the Right to Information Act, the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006 was notified vide No. F.13011/4/2005 – IPR dated 21.6.2006. However, careful study prompted the Commission to recommend proposal for amendment to the Rules as per Rule 19 of the Right to Information Rules, 2006. The State Government, in effect, notified fresh Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2010 vide No. F.13011/4/2008 – IPR dated 20.9.2010 which was made effective on its publication in the Official Gazetted on 24.11.2010.

As provided under section 18 of the Act, it is the duty of the Information Commission to receive and inquire into complaint from any person relating to access to information under the control of the public authorities. The Commission is also dealing with and disposing of appeals against the decisions of the Appellate Authority as per section 19(3) of the Act. The Commission is empowered to impose penalty on the Public Information Officer and it can also recommend disciplinary action against defaulting Public Information Officer. The decision of the Commission is binding on the public authority.

To enable the Commission function properly, the State Government sanctioned the following posts:-

During 2010 – 2011, as many as 115 public authorities submitted the reports pertaining to their authorities out of which 84 public authorities received 736 applications from the public, which may be seen at Annexure – 3. The Mizoram Information Commission also received 12 complaints and 8 second appeals during the period. It was observed that these complaints and appeals had been lodged with the Commission due, in most cases, to the ignorance of the Act and the Rules by the public authorities, especially the designated officials. The Commission expressed its sincere desire that every public authority should make concerted efforts to study the Act carefully and understand its provisions correctly for effective implementation of the Act. During the period, no penalty was imposed on, nor was there any disciplinary action recommended against, any erring State Public Information Officer.

The Commission observed that a number of citizens approached the Commission to get hold of application form for seeking information as if there is a prescribed form of application. The Commission would like to reiterate that there is no prescribed format of application for seeking information. The application can be made on plain paper, either in English, Hindi or the official language of the area in which the application is made. However, the application should contain the name and complete postal address of the applicant.

The Commission was allotted a meager sum of R. 6.00 lakhs under the head 'Advertisement and Publicity' which was utilized for display advertisement of Right to Information Slogans and for organizing Right to Information awareness campaigns at various place.

Realizing the need to inculcate Right to Information awareness at a larger scale, a suggestion was made to the State Government for inclusion of the RTI Act in the syllabi of schools and colleges. It is gratifying to note that the suggestion received a positive response and the matter is under active consideration of the State Government.

It is seen from the report submitted by various public authorities that there has been a good progress in the implementation of the provisions of the RTI Act by the public authorities and gradual awareness has also been made by the general public. However, there is no point of satisfaction. Much more remains to be expected and achieved. Perfection is our goal, and we will leave no stone unturned to achieve to desired goal.
