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CHAPTER – 1

INTRODUCTION

The Right to Information Act, enacted by the Parliament, was assented to by the President of India on 15.06.2005. The Act extends to the whole of India except the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

The main objective of the Act is to provide for setting out practical regime of the right to information for the citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authority in order to promote transparency, accountability in the functioning of every public authority and also to contain corruption.

While some of the provisions of the Act came into force at once, some came into effect on the one hundred and twentieth day of its enactment. These provisions included obligations of public authorities, constitution of Central and State Information Commissions, designation of Public Information Officers and Assistants public Information Officers and the power to make rules by various competent authorities. All the Departments and undertakings of the various Governments and other Bodies established, constituted, owned, controlled or substantially financed by Governments including non- governmental organizations are covered by the Act. Every citizen of India has the right to information accessible under the Act which is held by or under the control of any public authority which includes inspection of documents or records, taking certified samples of material, obtaining information in the form of diskettes, floppies, tapes, videos, cassettes or in any other electronic mode or through printouts where such information is stored in a computer or in any other device.

The Mizoram Information Commission was constituted vide notification issued under No. F.13011/11/2005 – IPR dated 29. 06.2006 by the Department of Information and Public Relations, Government of Mizoram. The Commission started functioning with effect from 5th July, 2006 when Mr. Robert Hrangdawla, IAS (Rtd.) and Mr. K. Tlanthanga, IB (P) S (Rtd.) were sworn in as Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioner respectively. However, Mr. Robert Hrangdawla relinquished the post on 1.2.2010 on attaining the age of 65 years as per section 16 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005.

As required under section 25 of the Act, it is mandatory for the Central Information Commission and the State Information Commission to prepare a report on the implementation of the provisions of the Act each year and forward the same to the Central Government or the State Government for laying it before the Parliament or the State Legislature This report has been prepared in compliance with the provisions of the Act.

For effective implementation of the Right to Information Act, the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006, was made and notified by the nodal Department, the Department of Information and Public Relations, under No. F.13011/4/2005 – IPR dated 21.06.2006. However, there were certain defects which were highlighted in the First Report with the recommendation for amendment in accordance with the provisions of the Act. Subsequently, complete proposal and recommendation for amendment to the Rules were sent to the Government as per Rule 19 of the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006.

Powers of the State Information Commission under the Right to Information Act, 2005, may be summarized as follows:-

(a) Enquiries under section 18 of the Act :-

(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, it shall be the duty of the State Information Commission to receive and inquire into a complaint from any person -

- who has been unable to submit a request to a State Public Information Officer either by reason that no such officer has been appointed under this Act, or because the State Assistant Public Information Officer has refused to accept his or her application for information or appeal under this Act for forwarding the same to the State Public Information Officer or senior officer specified in sub – section (1) of section 19 or the State Information Commission, as the case may be;
- who has been refused access to any information requested under this Act;
- who has not been given a response to a request for information or access to information within the time limit specified under this Act;
- who has been required to pay an amount of fee which he or she considers unreasonable;
- who believes that he or she has been given incomplete, misleading or false information under this Act; and

- in respect of any other matter relating to requesting or obtaining access to records under this Act;

(2) Where the State Information Commission is satisfied that there are reasonable grounds to inquire into the matter, it may initiate an inquiry in respect thereof.

(3) The State Information Commission shall, while inquiring into any matter under this section, have the same powers as are vested in a civil court while trying a suit under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1980, in respect of the following matters, namely :-

- summoning and enforcing the attendance of persons and compel them to give oral or written evidence on oath and to produce the documents or things;
- requiring the discovery and inspection of the documents;
- receiving evidence on affidavit;
- requisitioning any public record or copies thereof from any court or office;
- issuing summons for examination of the witnesses or documents; and
- any other matter which may be prescribed.

(4) Notwithstanding anything inconsistent contained in any other Act of State Legislature, the State Information Commission may, during the inquiry of any complaint under this Act, examine any record to which this Act applies which is under the control of the public authority, and no such record may be withheld from it on any grounds.

(b) Appeals under section 19 of the Act:-

(1) Any person who does not receive a decision within the time specified in sub – section (1) or clause (a) of sub – section (3) of section 7 or is aggrieved by a decision of the State Public Information Officer may, within thirty days from the expiry of such period or from the receipt of such a decision, prefer an appeal to such officer who is senior in rank to the State Public Information Officer in each public authority:

Provided that such officer may admit the appeal after the expiry of the period of thirty days if he or she is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from filing the appeal in time.

(2) Where an appeal is preferred against an order made by a State Public Information Officer under section 11 to disclose third party information, the appeal by the concerned third party shall be made within thirty days from the date of the order.

(3) A second appeal against the decision under sub – section (1) shall lie within ninety days from the date on which the decision should have been made or was actually received with the State Information Commission.

Provided that the State information Commission may admit the appeal after the expiry of the period of ninety days if it is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by sufficient cause from filing the appeal in time.

(4) If the decision of the State Public Information Officer against which an appeal is preferred relates to information of a third party, the State Information Commission shall give a reasonable opportunity of being heard to that third party.

(5) In any appeal proceedings, the onus to prove that a denial of a request was justified shall be on the State Public Information Officer who denied the request.

(6) Appeal under sub – section (1) or sub – section (2) shall be disposed of within thirty days of the receipt of the appeal or within such extended period not exceeding a total of forty-five days from the date of filing thereof, as the case may be, for reasons to be recorded in writing.

(7) The decision of the State Information Commission shall be binding.

(8) In its decision, the State Information Commission has the power to -

(a) require the public authority to take any such steps as may be necessary to secure compliance with the provisions of this Act, including –

- by providing access to information, if so requested in a particular form;
- by appointing a State Public Information Officer, as the case may be;
- by publishing certain information or categories of information;
- by making necessary changes to its practices in relation to the maintenance, management and destruction of records;
- by enhancing the provision of training on the right to information for its officials;
- by providing it with an annual report in compliance with clause (b) of sub – section (1) of section 4;

(b) require the public authority to compensate the complainant for any loss or other detriment suffered.

(c) impose any of the penalties provided under this Act;

(d) reject the application.

- (9) The State Information Commission shall give notice of its decisions, including any right of appeal to the complainant and the public authority.
- (10) State Information Commission shall decide the appeal in accordance with such procedure as may be prescribed.

Penalties under Section 20 of the Act:-

- (1) Where the State Information Commission, at the time of deciding any complaint or appeal, is of the opinion that the State Public Information Officer, without any reasonable cause, refused to receive an application for information or has not furnished information within the time specified under sub – section (1) of section 7 or malafidely denied the request for information or knowingly given incorrect, incomplete or misleading information or destroyed information which was the subject of the request or obstructed in any manner in furnishing the information, it shall impose a penalty of two hundred and fifty rupees each day till application is received or information is furnished. However, the total amount of such penalty shall not exceed twenty –five thousand rupees:

Provided that the State Public Information Officer, shall be given a reasonable opportunity of being heard before any penalty is imposed on him;

Provided further that the burden of providing that he acted reasonably and diligently shall be on the State Public Information Officer.

- (2) Where the State Information Commission, at the time of deciding any complaint or appeal, is of the opinion that the State Public Information Officer has, without any reasonable cause and persistently, failed to receive an information or has not furnished information specified under sub – section (1) of Section 7 or malafidely denied the request for information or knowingly given incorrect, incomplete or misleading information or destroyed information which was the subject of the request or obstructed in any manner in furnishing the information, it shall recommend for disciplinary action against the State Public Information Officer under the service rules applicable to him.

CHAPTER – 2

SALIENT FEATURES OF RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

The enactment of Right to Information Act, 2005, introduced a new era of governance in India and provided an opportunity for every person to seek and receive information held by every public authority under its control. The Act imposes a positive duty on governmental agencies to disseminate information to the people and gives every citizen the right to access information held by these agencies.

The Right to Information Act, 2005, prescribes disclosures of information suo moto on the working of the public authorities as well as designations of adequate number of Public Information Officers and Assistant Public Information Officers who will receive and process the requests for information from any citizen within the specified time. The Act empowers the Central Government and the State Governments to constitute Information Commissions to inquire into complaints, hear second appeals and guide implementation of the Act by various public authorities.

The main features of the Right to Information Act, 2005, are broadly summarized as follows:-

- (i) Every citizen of India can seek information from any public authority without specifying the reason for seeking the information.
- (ii) Public authorities are to furnish the required information to the applicants through the designated Public Information Officers within the specified time.

- (iii) The required information can be denied only under exemptions provided in the RTI Act, 2005.
- (iv) Person desirous of obtaining information under the Act has to make a request in writing to the Central Public Information Officer or State Public information Officer.
- (v) The application should be made either in English, Hindi or in the official language of the area in which the application is made.
- (vi) Fees for information as may be prescribed are chargeable. Persons belonging to BPL are not liable to pay any fee.
- (vii) When a request for information has been rejected, the State Public Information Officer shall communicate to the person making the request –
 - the reasons for such rejection;
 - the period within which an appeal against such rejection may be preferred; and
 - the particulars of the Appellate Authority.
- (viii) The Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer shall provide the required information or reject the request within 30 days of receipt of such request.
- (ix) Person aggrieved by the decision of the PIO has the right to prefer an appeal within 30 days before the First or Departmental Appellate Authority (DAA) designated by the concerned authority.

- (x) Person aggrieved by the decision of the First or Departmental Appellate Authority (DAA) has the right to prefer a second appeal within 90 days before the Central or State information Commission. The decision of the Central or State Information Commission is final and binding on the public authority.
- (xi) Information concerning the life and liberty of a person has to be given within 48 hours from receipt of the application.
- (xii) Every public authority is required to make voluntary disclosure of information of its functioning which is to be updated every year.
- (xiii) The public authorities are required to designate adequate number of Public Information Officers and Assistant Public Information Officers to provide information to the applicants.
- (xiv) The public authorities are required to designate the Appellate Authorities to consider and decide the first appeals against the decisions of the Public Information Officers.
- (xv) The Central or State information Commission has the power to impose penalty upon, and to recommend disciplinary action against, the Public Information Officer on grounds specified under the Act.
- (xvi) The provisions of the Act have an overriding effect on any other law for the time being in force including the provisions of the official Secret Act, 1923.

- (xvii) Courts (Civil and Criminal) have no jurisdiction under this Act.
- (xviii) The appropriate Government and competent authorities are empowered to make rules to carry out the provisions of the Act.
- (xix) The appropriate Government is required by sub – section (1) of section 26 to perform the following:-
- to develop and organize educational programmes to advance the understanding of the public as to how to exercise the rights contemplated under the Act;
 - to encourage public authorities to participate in the development and organization of educational programmes and to undertake such programmes themselves;
 - to promote timely and effective dissemination of accurate information by public authorities about their activities; and
 - to train State Public Information Officers of the public authorities and produce relevant training materials for use by the public authorities themselves.

CHAPTER – 3

THE MIZORAM RIGHT TO INFORMATION RULES, 2006.

Section 27(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005, provides that the appropriate Government may make rules to carry out the provisions of the Act. Accordingly, the Mizoram Right to Information Rules, 2006, was notified on 21.6.2006. These Rules came into force on the date of their publication in the Mizoram Gazette. The Rules prescribed certain rates of application fee for furnishing the required information to the applicants. The salient features of the Rules are as under:-

- (i) A citizen desirous of any information may apply in Form 'A' to the Public Information officer and make payment of required fee.
- (ii) Applicants belonging to BPL are not liable to pay application fee provided BPL card is produced.
- (iii) Rejection of application will have to be intimated by the Public Information Officer in Form 'C'.
- (iv) Appeal shall have to be filed in Form 'D' accompanied with required fees.
- (v) Any person aggrieved by the decision under sub – section (1) of Section 19 may prefer a second appeal before the State Information Commission in Form 'E' accompanied with prescribed fee.
- (vi) Fees/amounts to be charged for providing information may be seen under Second Schedule attached hereto.

- (vii) Every appeal made to the First Appellate Authority or to the Commission shall be accompanied by the following documents:-
- (a) self- attested copy of the order against which the appeal is being prepared;
 - (b) copies of documents relied upon by the appellant referred to in the appeal; and
 - (c) an index of the documents referred to in the appeal.
- (viii) In deciding the appeal, the Commission or the Appellate Authority may –
- (a) hear oral or written evidence on oath or an affidavit from concerned persons;
 - (b) peruse or inspect the documents, public records or copies thereof;
 - (c) enquire through authorized officer further details or facts;
 - (d) hear State Public Information Officer, State Assistant Public information Officer or such senior officer who decided the first appeal, or such person against whom the complaint is made, as the case may be.
 - (e) hear third party (applicable to the Commission only); and
 - (f) receive evidence on affidavit from State Public Information Officer, State Assistant Public Information Officer, senior officer who decided the first appeal, or such person against whom the complaint is made, or third party, as the case may be.

- (ix) In case of difference of opinion in deciding the appeal or complaint, as the case may be, the Commission shall abide by majority of opinion.
- (x) The State Government has the power to issue guidelines not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act.
- (xi) Penalty imposed on the Public Information Officer shall be deposited by the officer to the State budget through Treasury challan under the appropriate Head within 30 days.
- (xii) The State Public Information Officers and the State Assistant Public Information Officers are required to maintain register in Form 'F' (1) and Form 'F' (2) respectively for recording the details of applications received and information supplied to the applicants.
- (xiii) The State Public Information Officers / State Assistant Public Information Officer is required to maintain cash register in Form 'G'.
- (xiv) The First Appellate Authority (DAA) is required to maintain register in Form 'H'.
- (xv) The State Government, either in consultation or on recommendation of the Commission, may add to, delete from or alter or amend the Rules which is required to be approved by the Cabinet and to be laid before the State Legislature.

CHAPTER - 4

THE MIZORAM INFORMATION COMMISSION

The Mizoram Information Commission started functioning with effect from 5th July, 2006 when Mr. Robert Hrangdawla, IAS (Rtd) and Mr. K. Tlanthanga, IB(P)S (Rtd) were sworn in as Chief Information Commissioner and Information Commissioner respectively. However, Mr. Robert Hrangdawla demitted office on 1.2.2010 on completion of 65 years as per Section 16 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 and no Chief Information Commissioner has been appointed since and the Commission functioned with the lone Information Commissioner during the reporting period. In this connection, the Commission observed as follows:-

Section 10 (2) provides that the State Information Commission shall consist of –

- (a) the State Chief Information Commissioner, *and*
- (b) such number of Information Commissioners as may be deemed necessary.

Under section 15(4), the general superintendence, direction and management of the affairs of the State Information Commission is vested in the Chief Information Commissioner who will exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things which may be exercised or done by the State Information Commission autonomously without being subjected to directions by any other authority under the Right to Information Act. It will be seen, therefore, that the Chief Information Commissioner is the exclusive authority in the overall affairs of the State Information Commission and his appointment is the prime importance since the incumbent has relinquished the post. Even though the State Government has allowed the Information Commissioner to discharge the functions of the Chief Information Commissioner, there have been practical difficulties for the Information

Commissioner in the real application unless he is appointed as Chief Information Commissioner since the Chief Information Commissioner alone is the real authority in the affairs of the State Information Commission under the Act. In case the State Government has a mind that the Commission should be manned by one person, then it is the considered opinion of the Commission that the appointment of the Chief Information Commissioner is the first and foremost requirement under the Act.

In order to carry out the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005, the Mizoram RTI Rules, 2006 was notified on 21.6.2006 to be effective from the publication in the Mizoram Gazette. The Chief Information Commissioner has been delegated full financial power in respect of the establishment of the State Information Commission in pursuance of Rule 3(1) (a) of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1978 read with para 5 of the State of Mizoram Adaptation of Laws and Order (No. 2) of 1975 vide No. G.17012/1/2002 – F. Est dated 11.10.2006 issued by Finance Department of the Government of Mizoram. The State Government in the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms has also approved filling up of Group ‘C’ and ‘D’ posts under the State Information Commission by direct recruitment in relaxation of ban being imposed by the Government vide No. B.16012/1/03 – P&AR dated 8.3.2007. Accordingly, 3 posts of UDC, 3 posts of LDC and 10 posts of IV Grade were filled up during the year under report.

The Mizoram Information Commission has been receiving and enquiring into the complaints received from the complainants relating to access to information under the control of public authorities and deciding them on merit keeping in view the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005. The Commission has also been dealing with and disposing of appeals against the decisions of the Appellate Authorities. The Commission has been empowered to impose penalty on the State Public Information

Officer and it can also recommend disciplinary action against such erring State Public Information Officer. The decision of the Commission is final and binding on the public authority.

The State Government has sanctioned the following posts for the smooth functioning of the Commission:-

However, despite the above sanctioned posts, the Commission functioned with the services of the Secretary appointed by the Commission and that of the Sr. PPS, the PPS, the Superintendent, the Private Secretary, the 2 Assistants and the Steno – III provided by the State Government. As mentioned in the foregoing paragraph, the posts of Upper Division Clerk, Lower Division Clerk and IV Grade were filled up during the period under report.

The Government of Mizoram has allocated a budgetary provision of RS.129.29 lakhs during the year 2009 – 2010 with the following break up:-

During 2009 – 2010, 695 applications were received by 90 public authorities against 177 applications by 37 public authorities during 2008 – 2009, details of which are indicated at Annexure 3. The Commission also received 13 complaints and 3 second appeals as per records maintained by it. However, these information do not necessarily tally with the information furnished by public authorities as a number of public authorities against which complaints and appeals were instituted did not submit the information. Despite the gradual awareness of the Right to Information Act by the public authorities, the complaints received by the Commission still pertained mostly to the delay in giving timely information to the applicants by the public authorities. It is, therefore, extremely essential for all public authorities, especially the Public Information Officers, to have thorough

knowledge of the Right to Information Act and the Rules made thereunder. While it may be for the State Government to conduct and impart training and awareness to the public authorities and to the general public as provided under sub – section (1) of section 26 of the Right to Information Act, the Commission has supplemented the drive in the form of sponsorship, display advertisement of RTI slogans and conducting awareness campaigns at various places inside the State with the meagre sum allotted under the appropriate head by the State Government. During the period under report, a penalty amounting to Rs. 25,000/- was imposed on one State Public Information Officer which was complied with. However, no disciplinary action was recommended against defaulting Public Information Officer.

CONCLUSION

The increase in the number of applications received by the public authorities during this year as mentioned in the foregoing paragraph indicated that the awareness and participation of the public in exercising their right to get information have escalated tremendously. Similarly, gradual awareness of the Act and Rules by the public authorities has resulted not only in timely information given to the applicants, but also in helping the needy applicants and transferring the applications to other public authorities. However, we should not be complacent; much more remains to be desired. Yet, the pace is furthered again towards perfection.
